On September 10, 2009, at approximately 12:00 AM, two suspects entered the Cranbury School. Shortly after making entry our officers responded to the scene and confronted the suspects. The suspects fled in the direction of Plainsboro Road.

A perimeter was established and the New Jersey State Police Aviation Unit checked the area with a helicopter. Meanwhile the Cranbury School was searched with K-9 units from the Hightstown Police Department and the New Jersey State Police.

The two suspects are described as:

Suspect #1

- White male
- Dark hair
- Clean-shaven
- Blue jeans
- Black and white flannel work shirt

Suspect #2

- Hispanic or Indian male
- Black hair
- Black sweatshirt
- Black shorts
- Possibly wearing sandals

After securing the Cranbury School and consulting with School Administrator John Haney the school was opened at the regular time.

Residents are advised that if they see police activity in their neighborhood that they should lock their doors. We only have one dispatcher on duty for both Cranbury and Hightstown, please DO NOT call the police dispatcher unless you can provide useful information.
