

E-WASTE PROGRAM COLLECTION AT THE RECYCLE SHED 2017

Cranbury Township is extremely happy to inform its residents that the e-waste collection program will begin January 6, 2017 at the Recycle Shed!

The Recycle Shed is located at 100 Dey Road (DPW Yard) and will be open from 9am to 12pm on the first Friday of every month, unless that Friday is a legal holiday, then the shed will be open on the second Friday of the month.

Acceptable e-waste items (see below list), fluorescent bulbs (compact bulbs (CFLs) and tube bulbs no longer than 3') and formed polystyrene will be accepted during these hours.

Acceptable e-waste items include:

APC/UPS (battery backup & power supply)	CABLES/WIRING (extension cords/string lights)
CONTROLLERS	COPIERS
E-READERS	KEYBOARDS
LAPTOPS	MAINFRAME/SERVERS
PRINTERS/FAX	SCANNERS
STEREOS	TELEPHONES (office, cell, home)
TONER CARTRIDGES	TELEVISIONS
TYPWRITERS	VIDEO EQUIPMENT

Please adhere to this list. The recycle vendor charges a fee per pound for these items. Media e-waste (CDs, DVDs, VHS tape (limit to 25 per household) cell phones, button and rechargeable batteries) can be dropped off in the DPW office at Town Hall, during business hours. Due to the cost of these program, this service is available for Cranbury residents only.

Large e-waste items can be scheduled for pick-up service with the White Goods program. There is a fee of \$10 per item. The pick-up service is scheduled for the 2nd Wednesday of the month but arrangements must be made the Monday prior to this day. Call 609-664-3129 to make arrangements.
