**TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING**

The meeting of the Cranbury Township Board of Health was held in Town Hall in Cranbury, New Jersey on June 4 at 7:00 p.m.

**CALL TO ORDER**

With a quorum present, John Jackson, chair of the Board of Health called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and Wendy W. Borg acted as Recording Secretary of the meeting.

**PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL REPORTS**

The Board reviewed the substance of the May 2012 Health Report and the Environmental report for April 2012.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Rabid Cat – The county health department notified a stray cat was sent to the state Department of Health Laboratory and tested positive for rabies on May 17.

School Dental Sealant program – Mr. Jackson will contact the Board of Education.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Proposed Farmer's Market – Ms. Goetz explained the plans for this market, proposed to be held on Friday afternoons starting July 13 through September. The plans are for approximately ten vendors to sell local fruit, vegetables, honey, flowers, dog biscuits and soap. The Board endorsed the market on a motion by George Smith; seconded by Roop Grewal. The Board cannot sponsor the Market because it will be inspected. Dr. Grewal suggested an organic vendor be included.

Injured Animals – Dr. Grewal questioned the procedure if an injured stray animal or bird is found. The Board recommended a call to Director Jerry Thorne of Public Works during work hours, and a call to the police after hours.
