Mosquito Spraying – Mrs. Palocz came to express her concern about potential mosquitoes in the drained Brainerd Lake. The county mosquito commission will be

coming in this week to assess and will treat the lake with larvacide. Ms. Lloyd gave Mrs. Palocz her contact information.

Township Newsletter – Submissions will include a reminder for cat and dog licenses, septic tank cleaning, and ridding standing water on properties to keep mosquitoes from breeding.
