TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING

The meeting of the Cranbury Township Board of Health was held in Town Hall, 23A North Main Street, Cranbury, New Jersey on June 6, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

With a quorum present, Laura Collins Zurfluh, sub Chair of the Board of the Health, called the meeting to order at 7:09 p.m. and Wendy Borg acted as Recording Secretary of the meeting.

The Board reviewed the substance of the May 2016 Health Report and the Environmental report for April 2016.

May: One retail food inspection was satisfactory. One recreational bathing inspection was satisfactory. A complaint of high grass on Stockton Drive resulted in a site visit and notice of violation. Grass was cut, complaint closed.

Court cases for failure to obtain dog licenses were held on two dates in May. Four residents pled guilty and were issued a fine plus court costs. Two residents did not appear and bench warrants were issued.

Love Your Dog doggie day care establishment was recently licensed by Cranbury and is pending inspection.

OLD BUSINESS

Public Service Activities – Licensing – Dr. Collins will contact school to discuss adding rabies education to the health curriculum. Adding information to reminder cards will be discussed again in September. Dr. Collins will also discuss with Township Clerk the biannual census and the possibility of colored license tags.

NEW BUSINESS – Dr. Michael Young has retired, moved and sold the Cranbury Animal Hospital. He is no longer the Township Veterinarian. Dr. Collins will visit the new owner of the Cranbury Animal Hospital to see if he could be the new Township Vet.
