HPC would like to review a marked plot plan indicating the placement of the shed since there is an existing garage in the back yard.

103 North Main Street (B25,L59) In Historic District; application was received for installation of an emergency generator that will be located on the north elevation. Pictures were supplied of location. This application is considered minor and has been approved by Ms. Marlow, HPC Chair.
