

ICE - In Case of Emergency

Recently we have received questions regarding notifications involving people who are unable to articulate emergency contact information. The solution is simple. Besides keeping emergency contact information on your person you may also program your cellular telephone with emergency contact information.

Follow these simple directions:

Step 1:

Create a New contact in your cellular telephone.

Step 2:

Name the contact ICE (In Case of Emergency)

Step 3:

Program the number for your emergency contact. You are done.

For young children you can write the emergency information on an index card, laminate the index card with an adhesive laminate (available at office supply stores) and place the card in the child's shoe. Other types of identification for children are available on-line.
