

CRANBURY TOWNSHIP RECRUITING PART-TIME 2017 DOG/CAT CENSUS WORKERS

The Township is currently recruiting temporary staff to perform the annual dog/cat census project.

These positions require going door to door in Cranbury Township, to contact dog/cat owners, so that the Township can verify and report the number of dogs/cats per residence. The hours are 4 – 8pm during the week and 8:30 am – 5:00 pm weekends. There will be no work on September 4, 2017.

The deadline for completion of the dog/cat census survey is Friday, September 8, 2017.

To qualify, candidates must:

- Be able to explain the census to dog/cat owners
- Be professional and at ease with the public
- Be comfortable around animals
- Have a clean driver's license record
- Have access to a car for use in performing this job
