The Township of Cranbury Recycling Department is pleased to announce that the Recycle Shed located at 100 Dey Road (DPW Yard) will be collecting e-waste between the hours of 9am – 12pm. The collection schedule will be the first Friday each month (if a legal holiday-the shed will open on the 2nd Friday that month).

Please take note of the comprehensive list of acceptable and non-acceptable items. Kindly adhere to the list. A fine will be assessed by the vendor for any **NON ACCEPTED ITEMS** mixed in with the **ACCEPTED ITEMS** load.
