RE: 2017 Herbicide Treatment Notification – Brainerd Lake

Dear Residents:

Princeton Hydro, LLC (Princeton Hydro) is providing you with the following notification letter informing you of the proposed aquatic herbicide application at Brainerd Lake to control the growth of nuisance aquatic weed growth.

Princeton Hydro is proposing the application of the EPA-registered contact herbicides *Reward* (diquat dibromide) and/or *Clipper* (flumioxazin). The herbicide application is expected to be conducted during the week of May 16, 2017.

Residents are instructed to shut down any irrigation systems which pump water from the lake and to stop any use of the lake water for irrigation/watering purposes until May 20, 2017. The lake water should also not be used to provide drinking water for livestock or domestic pets until May 20, 2017.
