

Cranbury Township Ordinance # 08-16-17

TOWNSHIP OF CRANBURY
COUNTY OF MIDDLESEX

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF A STORM
WATER DRAINAGE AND UTILITY EASEMENT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY
OVER, UPON AND WITHIN BLOCK 26, LOT 29.21, CRANBURY
TOWNSHIP TAX MAP BY EMINENT DOMAIN

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Cranbury has determined that it is in the public interest to facilitate the construction of an affordable housing project to be located on Block 26, Lot 3 (“ the Affordable Housing Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that it is necessary to acquire a storm water drainage and utility easement and right-of-way (the “Easement”) on property owned by the Christian and Cathrin Torske at Block 26, Lot 29.21 (the “ Owner”) in order to facilitate the construction of the Affordable Housing Project; and

WHEREAS, the Township has obtained an appraisal from Martin Appraisal Associates, Inc. regarding the fair market value for the Easements and has attempted to negotiate in good faith with the Owner but has been unable to reach agreement on the terms of an easement agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Township’s appraisal indicates that the fair market value of the Easement is \$3425.00;

WHEREAS, said monies are available within the Township’s budget; and

WHEREAS, in order to insure that the Project may continue in a timely fashion, the Township Administration has recommended to the Township Committee that it authorize the acquisition of the Easement by eminent domain as permitted by *N.J.S.A. 20:3-1 et. seq*; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Cranbury, Middlesex County, NJ as follows:

(1.) The Township wishes to acquire a storm water drainage and utility easement and right-of-way on certain real property owned by Christian and Cathrin Torske, located at Block 26, Lot 29.21 In the Township of Cranbury, Middlesex County, NJ for the purpose of storm water management more particularly shown on the Exhibit attached hereto, for the consideration of \$3425.00; and

(2.) The Mayor and Clerk and Township Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary actions to acquire said Easements through eminent domain as permitted by *N.J.S.A. 20:3-1 et. seq.*, including the execution of all necessary documents, upon final passage, approval and publication of said ordinance according to law.

(3.) The Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

The ordinance published herewith was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Cranbury, in the County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, on August 8, 2016.
