

**MINUTES OF THE
CRANBURY TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF RECREATION COMMISSION
August 24, 2017**

TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING

The August meeting of the Cranbury Township Board of Recreation Commission was held in Town Hall on August 24, 2017.

CALL TO ORDER

With a quorum present, Ed Sekelsky, Chairman for the Township Recreation Commission, called the meeting to order at 7:05pm, and Joyce Martin acted as Recording Secretary of the meeting.

MINUTES

The minutes from the April and May 2017 meeting were approved as a quorum was present.

PERMITS/BUDGET:

OLD BUSINESS

Senior Center: Betty Conover addressed the board. There is a lunch program scheduled for October 17th at the Cranbury Inn. It is entitled The History and Ghosts of the Inn. Lunch will be served and Gay Ingegneri will host. This is a town-wide event, not just limited to seniors. The cost is \$28.00 per person. Betty also spoke with the Ingegneris to discuss offering more of these types of programs to Cranbury seniors and residents. If held in town, we don't have to get an expensive bus to transport people. On an aside: regarding transportation, we will investigate whether locals companies (i.e, Cranbury Limo, A-1 Limo, etc.) can give us special pricing for senior transportation to ease the cost. Perhaps the county has some suggestions also. Betty would like to do a town-wide mailing to get

feedback on the senior programs being offered and what Cranbury seniors would like to see in program offerings, if they would like to meet more than twice a month, "Movie Mondays" and/or Silver Screen Night, Karaoke, line-dancing? She also discussed purchase of the 2018 movie license. Perhaps we can partner with the Library? If we purchase we could open up movie nights to the entire town.

Heritage Park Update: Will be addressed at the next meeting.

Recreation Programs: Doug MacMillan from Mercer Oaks Golf Course addressed the commission on adding a new recreation program – Beginner Golf. It would be a 4-week program – 1 day a week. Younger children (2nd – 5th) would meet one day and older kids (6th and up) would meet on another day. It would run mid September through October. Ratio of kids to instructor would be 5-1 and the program would run one hour. All instructors are teaching professionals. The fee would be \$125 and would include use of facilities, range balls, teaching aids and a t-shirt. Doug will email Joyce details and she will draft a flyer for Doug and Ken's review.

Movie Night: Pick out a Friday night – coordinate with the school and try to do before Halloween.

There being no further business, Donna Eisenhauser motioned the meeting be adjourned, and Courtney Kohut seconded it. The meeting was thereupon adjourned at 8:30 pm.
